



Jamboree Activity Fee

NZ Scout Jamboree is the largest event in the National Scouting calendar. Every three years over 1000 volunteers put together 10 action-packed days for over 2500 youth members of the Scouting movement. It's the event of a lifetime for many participants and often the highlight of their Scouting careers.

The Jamboree Activity Fee described below includes cost of programme and activities, the site and facilities hire, catering, and incidentals associated with running a Jamboree. Remember that Troops will need to add on any costs of uniform, transport, and equipment needed for themselves.

The adventure begins erecting tents, building a small town with streets and navigating the 114 hectares available. Scouts meet neighbours who will share fence boundaries and will be introduced to new friends as soon as they arrive. Scouts are provided with facilities to "shop" for food, cook for themselves and learn about menu structure and nutrition on camp. Developing social and intellectual skills.

Scouts are given the opportunity to try things above and beyond a normal Scout camp. They will be challenged individually and collectively, pushed out of their comfort zones, entertained and inspired. Scouts learn to both be independent and to work together with many different people and small teams to participate in various challenges. Scouts will learn new skills and responsibilities, meet people from across the world and very likely return home from the Jamboree a different Scout and person altogether!

The fees for the 22nd New Zealand Scout Jamboree are:

- **Scouts** **\$905**
- **Leaders in Troops** **\$625**
- **Staff (inc. VST, Host Corps, Adults)** **\$300**
