Key Mysteries Uncovered

Scout Eligibility

- Invested as a Scout as at 28/12/2019
- Bronze Scout Award
- 6 nights camping **as a Scout**
- Approval by Scout, Parent, Scout Leader
- Able to participate in activities and arrangements designed for 11 – 15 years olds.
- Able to work effectively in a patrol without Scout Leader supervision
- International Scouts will be aged between 11 and 15 years old on 28/12/2019 and have the approval of their NSO

Venturer Support Team

- Invested Venturers eligible
- Bronze Venturer Award
- Separation between Scouts and Venturers
- Service focus
- Able to work well with other Leaders / Adults
- Separate programme

Queen's Scout Team

- **All** Queen's Scouts and BP Award recipients
- Working in key Jamboree roles
- Showcasing Scouting's best

Site

- Mystery Creek Events Centre, Hamilton
- May be a Satellite site or sites

Troop Size

- 6 Patrols with 6 Scouts in each Patrol
- Minimum of 4 Patrols of 6 Scouts – condition that will merged with other Patrols – International or from New Zealand.

Caregivers

- Scouts with special needs will be able to be supported by a caregiver, with the approval of the Scout Leader and Jamboree Troop Leader

Activities

- Water, sea, outdoor adventure, Air and all aspects of SPICES
- Lots onsite
- One night offsite in Patrols

Jamboree Length

- 10 days – one extra day from past Jamboree, including a "settle in" day
- Finish on 7 January 2020

Jamboree Rules

- Scout Law and Promise
- Each Adult invested into the Jamboree
- SCOUTS New Zealand Policy: Alcohol, Uniform, Youth Development, Transition and Adult Development



Facilities Management

- Facilities will be managed at each site for activities, camping and catering

Troop Site Size

- Around 700m²

Tent spacing

- 1 metre between tents
- 3 metres cooking tents with gas equipment
- 1.5 metres from the boundary

Start date

- 28 December 2019

Family Camp

- Arrangement with camp at Narrows, near the Jamboree site (privately operated)

Jamboree Patrol

- Being sought from CNI Region
- Young Leader also being sought
- Would like Patrols in each region. Make up Jamboree Troop

Catering

- Jamboree Patrol involvement
- Supermarket arrangement
- Professional Nutritionist advice on quality and quantity

Communications

- Face to face – Roadshows
- Website
- Facebook
- Newsletters

Troop Leaders

- 1 Leader for each Patrol, plus a Troop Leader
- Selection Criteria
- Zone Leader/ Zone Scout Leader decisions
- Troop Leader Weekend late August 2019 to finalise “merge and meld”

Managers / Team Leaders

- Seek before Christmas
- Appointment by end of March 2018

Staff

- Seek from April 2018
- Appointments by end of 2018

Scout and Leader Support

- Jamboree organisation to focus on supporting Leaders and Staff to support Scouts, as well as focus on Scouts directly

Registrations

- Close for Scouts in early July 2019 to allow Troops to be created

Jamboree Fee

- Scouts: \$800 - \$950
- Leaders / Staff: as low as possible \$150 - \$300
