ON YA BIKE

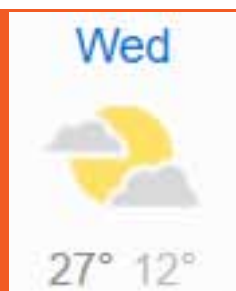
